1. Introduction

Our website (hereinafter referred to as the "Website") uses cookies and other related technologies (all technologies are referred to as "cookies" for convenience). Cookies are also placed by third parties that we have engaged. In the document below, we inform you about the use of cookies on our website.

2. What are cookies?

A cookie is a small, simple file that is sent along with the pages of this website and stored by your browser on the hard drive of your computer or other device. The information stored in them can be returned to our servers or to the servers of the relevant third parties during your next visit.

3. What are scripts?

A script is a piece of programming code that is used to make our websites function properly and interactively. This code runs on our server or on your device.

4. What is a web beacon?

A web beacon (or pixel tag) is a small, invisible text or image on a website that is used to monitor website traffic. For this purpose, web beacons are used to store various data about you.

5. Cookies

5.1 Technical or functional cookies . Some cookies ensure that certain parts of the website function properly and that your user preferences are remembered. By placing functional cookies, we make it easier for you to visit our website. This way, you do not have to enter the same information repeatedly when you visit our website and, for example, items remain in your shopping cart until you have paid. We may place these cookies without your consent.

5.2.Preference cookies allow a website to remember information that changes the way the website behaves or looks, such as your preferred language or the region you are currently in. We need your consent for these cookies.

5.3 . Statistical cookies help website owners understand how to interact with website visitors by collecting and reporting information anonymously. We need your consent for these cookies.

5.4. Marketing cookies are used to track visitors on websites. The purpose is to display advertisements that are relevant and engaging to individual users, and thus more valuable to third-party publishers and advertisers. We need your consent for these cookies.

5.5 .. Unclassified cookies are cookies that we set together with the providers of the individual cookies. We need your consent for these cookies.

5.6. Third-party cookies from social networks , Google analytics , Google maps, Youtube , (see point 8) are cookies from third parties. We must have your consent for these cookies. When using them, your personal data is transferred to 3 countries.

6. Consent

When you visit our website for the first time, we will show you a pop-up window explaining about cookies. By clicking "Save Preferences", you agree to our use of the categories of cookies and plug-ins you have selected in the pop-up window as described in this Cookie Policy. You can disable the use of cookies through your browser, but please note that our website may no longer function properly.

We will retain your consent for a period of 5 years so that we can prove compliance with the obligation to the supervisory authority.

The period for which consent is granted is 13 months. If consent to cookies is not granted, the website visitor will be asked again after 6 months.

7. Enabling/disabling and deleting cookies

You can use your Internet browser to automatically or manually delete cookies. You can also specify that certain cookies may not be placed. Another option is to change your Internet browser settings so that you receive a message each time a cookie is placed. For more information about these options, please refer to the instructions in your browser's Help section.

Please note that if all cookies are disabled, our website may not function properly. If you delete cookies in your browser, they will be placed again with your consent when you visit our website again.

8. Use of social media plugins
